2. Apologies

3. Minutes of last meeting – 04/10/18

The McGhies at the harbour have applied for a change of windows – no objections

7. Saddell Signage

Tommy was not at meeting but updated ES before meeting – ABC conducted a sight visit last week to both Saddell and Carradale playgrounds to discuss Playground signs – no other updates.

8. Road signage

Julian Green emailed IB and said that the signs have been ordered and will be installed in December.

The Council are not happy with the delays and length of time this process has taken.

Anne Horn said she will let ABC know that any more delays will be completely unacceptable.

9. Bins – harbour – bay –new footpath

Both bins – all councillors to chase up – especially the Bay one.

RS asked who will now be moving the recycling as the company involved before have gone into liquidation – there is an alternative in place.

EB reported that there is always lots of broken glass on the ground after the bins have been emptied and could it be removed by the removal company.

RC told us that Stuart Clark visited the harbour area and spoke to the creelers about the waste that they are dumping and has organised for signs to this affect to be put up.

10. New footpath

Colin Burgess has said that the new path will be called Archie's Path.
